



Professor Stricker received a master's degree in medicine in 1977 and a doctorate in liver injury caused by drugs. After a more than 40-year history of drug safety research, including 20 years as head of the National Pharmacovigilance Center, he is one of the few active pioneers in drug safety. In 2001 he became a professor of Pharmaco Epidemiology. He is an expert in this field for the European Medicines Agency and the Dutch health authorities. He taught about 30 Ph.D. students and published more than 700 articles, many of which reached the lay media.
